



2015 Stud Package Terms and Conditions

Payment

- Stud packages will commence on receipt of full payment. Your mare will not be scanned or treated until payment has been received.
- We will forward an invoice for any additional treatment required which is not included in the stud package which must be paid within our 30 days credit terms. For any procedures involving significant expense we will endeavor to provide an estimate of charges before going ahead.
- We strongly recommend that your mare is insured and that you have informed your insurance company of the situation.

Mares with Fertility Problems

- If a problem with your mare is identified which could significantly reduce her chances of conceiving, we reserve the right to insist that the problem is treated and corrected prior to attempting to breed from her. Treatment of long term fertility problems is not included in stud packages and will therefore involve additional cost.

Repeated Attempts at Breeding

- In the cases of mares which repeatedly and unexpectedly fail to conceive, we reserve the right to insist that diagnostic tests are carried out (such as a swab from the uterus to check for sub-clinical infection or a biopsy of the uterus to check for degeneration) prior to further attempts at breeding. These tests are not included in the Stud Package and will therefore involve additional charges.
- Packages cannot be carried over until the following year.
- For mares arriving late in the season, if an ultrasound scan shows evidence that the reproductive tract is beginning to shut down for winter, we reserve the right not to make further attempts at breeding.

Shipped Semen

- In the event that transported semen arrives (from UK or abroad) without the appropriate documentation and health certification, it will be rejected in accordance with current legislation / guidelines and NOT used to inseminate your mare but you will still incur charges for one mare cycle. Please ensure that the vendor is fully aware of this whenever a semen shipment is arranged.

Passports

- You must have your mares passport. If the passport is not available or if the declaration in Section IX has not been completed to confirm the mare is NOT intended for human consumption, we will be restricted in the medications which we are allowed to administer and this could reduce the chances of your mare having a successful breeding.
